gether we seek to love each other and in doing so glorify our God!

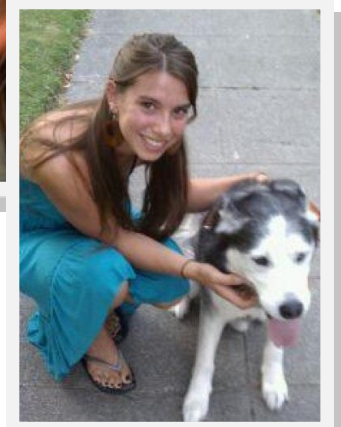
